

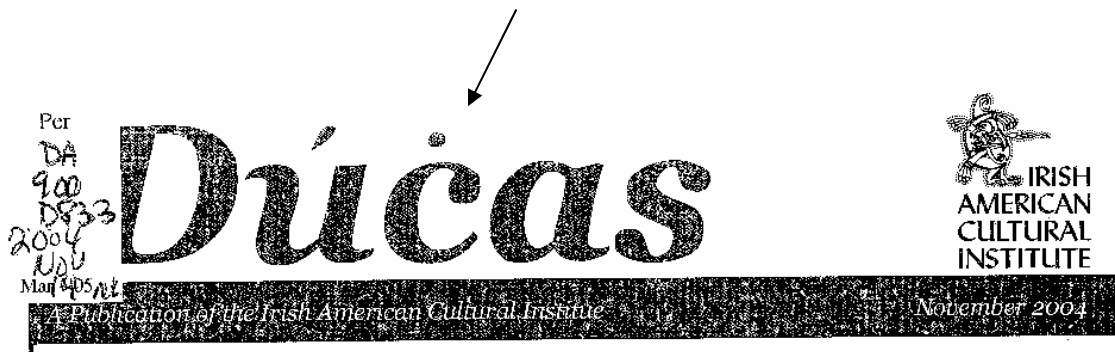

Irish Language – Dot over consonant, i.e., *ć* -- add “h” after consonant.

Example title: *Dúćas*

Dot over letter *ć*, add “h” after “c” in cataloging record, should be transcribed as:
Dúchas.



ALEPH system no.691411:

Main title **245 00 a** *Dúchas*

Add variant title transcribing as on piece:

Varying title **246 30 a** *Dúćas*
